Facts about the Proposed Three-Year Association of Keene Tutors (AKT) Contract 2012 – 2015:

The Association of Keene Tutors is comprised of 116 Tutors who provide assistance to Keene special education students.

Salaries:

- 2012-2013 total compensation (salary and benefits) increases by 1.75%.
- 2013-2014 total compensation (salary and benefits) increases by 1.75%.
- 2014-2015 total compensation (salary and benefits) increases by 1.75%.

Other Provisions:

- Changes the approval language for tuition/workshop reimbursement
- Tuition reimbursement changes from \$10,000 to \$10,100 in 2012-13, to \$10,350 in 2013-2014, and to \$10,550 in 2014-2015.
- Requires all employees to use direct deposit and enables the District to use electronic pay stubs.
- Contracts will no longer be printed; they will be posted electronically on the SAU 29 web site.
- Made minor clarifying language changes.

Voter Approval:

In 2012-2013, the District will need to raise and appropriate \$31,141. This will result in an increase of \$1.67 annually in property taxes on a \$100,000 home, if the assessment remains constant from 2011 to 2012. The approximate increased cost for 2013-2014 is \$31,723; and for 2014-2015 is \$32,258.
